

## Youth Writing Competition - Terms and Conditions of Entry Promoted by “The Mount Beauty Writers Festival” (“WE”, “US”, “THE PROMOTER”)

Period: Start Date: 8.00am AEST on 22 June 2026  
End Date: 11.59pm AEST on 24 August 2026  
No entries accepted after this time and date.

Verification Requirements: To be eligible to take part in this Competition you must have parental consent and fall within the following school year group on the date of submission:

- (a) Years 3 to 5
- (b) Years 6 to 8
- (c) Years 9 to 12

Entry Procedure: To enter the Competition, you must within the Period:

- (a) Choose a topic to write about;
- (b) Write a short story of nominated number of words by school year about it (see below); and

Prizes and Word Count by Year category

The winners of this Competition will receive the following cash prizes (in their respective age group):

Year	1st Prize	2nd Prize	Word Count
a) Years 3 to 5	\$100	\$50	200 to 1000

c) Years 9 to 12	\$350	\$200	1000 to 2000

Entry Restrictions:

- (a) Entries must be in Word format.
- (b) *Entries must* include full name of student, year and school.
- (c) Entrants must provide written parental consent as part of their entry.
- (d) Only one (1) entry is permitted per person.
- (e) Discriminatory or offensive language must NOT be used.
- (f) The Promoter may exclude entries at its sole discretion.
- (g) Only original works will be accepted and judged. Plagiarism and AI generated stories strictly prohibited and will not be tolerated.

Judging Process: Winner Notification: Claiming a Prize Entries will be judged by a panel appointed by the Mount Beauty Writers Festival.

Winner Notification: The names of the Winners and presentation of prizes of this Competition will be announced at the Writers Festival on 10 October 2026 at 12noon and participants must be available to attend. Parents are allowed to accompany them for the presentation. Finalists will be notified prior to the Festival. Winners will also be announced on the morning of 13 October 2026 on The Brunch Program by Fay Mason on Alpine FM Radio.

Claiming a Prize: Unclaimed prizes must be collected at Alpine FM Radio within **thirty days** from the winner having been announced, failing which the prize may be forfeited. This may be arranged with the radio show host Fay Mason directly.
